It is a vocation in which our educators share in the parent's role of forming the children entrusted to the school's care. This never works. Parents and teachers are a team and, as I said earlier, we are doing our best to give the children good values, which would supplement what you as parents do at home. I ask you as parents to give your complete support and cooperation to the teaching staff in the matter of the formation of our children.

The children continue to impress me with their insights and the depth of many of their questions. I love their enthusiasm and pray that it will never be stifled. The desire to seek for truth lies at the centre of human endeavour, be it scientific truth, spiritual truth or any other such striving. For us as Catholics, we believe that Jesus is the Way, the Truth and the Life, so the search for truth and embracing of truth, lies at the heart of our Faith. Yes, we love science too!

KAYLEIGH BENJAMIN: FRIENDS

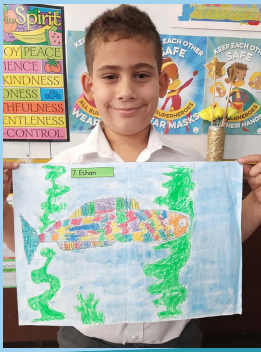
